NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Boards of Directors (collectively, the “**Boards**”) of Painted Prairie Metropolitan District Nos. 2-10 (collectively, the “**Districts**”), in the City of Aurora, Colorado, will hold a special meeting on May 28, 2026 at 3:30 P.M., at 5750 DTC Parkway, Suite 210, Greenwood Village, CO 80111 and via teleconferencing and can be joined through the directions below:

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT At this meeting, it is anticipated that the Boards will make a final determination to enter into and incur a multiple fiscal year financial obligation requiring the imposition of ad valorem property taxes in the form of that certain ARI Mill Levy Pledge Agreement to be entered into between the Districts and the Fletcher Regional Improvement Authority (“FRIA”) (the “ARI Mill Levy Pledge Agreement”) in relation to the issuance by FRIA of its Senior Special Revenue Bonds, Series 2026A and Subordinate Special Revenue Bonds, Series 2026B and any other obligations of the Authority to be secured by the Pledge Agreement in accordance with the terms thereof (the “Bonds”). The ARI Mill Levy Pledge Agreement is expected to be executed and delivered by the Districts for the purpose of pledging certain revenues generated by the Districts’ imposition of a limited mill levy (comprising the ARI Mill Levy required by the terms of the Districts’ Service Plan) to the funding of costs and expenses of FRIA, including, but not limited to, the repayment of a portion of the Bonds, which are being issued for the purpose of paying or reimbursing the costs of public improvements benefitting the Districts.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN THAT pursuant to the Supplemental Public Securities Act, no legal or equitable action brought with respect to any legislative acts or proceedings in connection with the authorization or issuance of such Bonds may be commenced more than thirty days after the authorization of such Bonds pursuant to the aforementioned resolution.

The Board will also take up such other business as may come before the Board. The meeting is open to the public.

Pursuant to the provisions of the Supplemental Public Securities Act, one or more members of the Board may participate in this meeting and may vote on the foregoing matters through the use of a conference telephone or other telecommunications device. There will be at least one person present at the physical location posted on this notice.

This notice is given by order of the Boards of the Districts, and shall be posted at one public place within each District and on the Districts’ website, not less than 24 hours prior to the meeting.
